[Teaching for Life - Sunday School/Preschool](#) offers a positive set of nine lessons with reproducible graphics to help teach pro-life concepts. Although it is geared toward a class setting, for \$10, it is affordable for Lutheran homeschoolers also.

[Alive Before You Were Born: God's Gift of Life](#) by Kim Bestian is a "simple-concept illustrated children's book" about the relationship between God and every child, from the moment of conception.
